



## Course: The Rational Unified Process Experience

**Length: 4 Days**

### Course Description:

This IBM Rational Unified Process (RUP) Experience course is designed to advance the capability of experienced software development team members to become more aware of the other roles in a team, ensuring that they are better able to be part of a successful collaborative team.

The approach of the course is to simulate the life of a real RUP project, following a case-study to realise a solution as a team, whilst experiencing all the roles and disciplines of a team and participating in many of the key activities. The majority of the RUP lifecycle focus is on the Inception and Elaboration phases, highlighting the importance of completing the phases correctly, prior to moving onto the additional challenges of the Construction and Transition phases. For each phase the group also learns how to tailor RUP to the needs of the case study and any project, defining and refining a process definition for the whole team. Throughout each of the four phases the instructor will also provide numerous examples of real-life situations where the taught practices were adopted both correctly and incorrectly, highlighting the value to be gained, and the mistakes that can be made.

The course can optionally be delivered as a “boot-camp” for a new project team as it starts to form and learn the techniques required, using the real scenario of the project as a driver for the exercises and delivering real project work products to advance the project before it actually starts.

*Other delivery options include remote-learning via weekly 2-hour web-casts over a period of 8 weeks, where 2-hours of homework are also set and reviewed each week. This can also be delivered “out-of-hours” to minimise the impact on daily project work.*

### Objectives:

- > Refresh the key principles of RUP
- > Learn the key activities and work products of a RUP project
- > Experience the team-dynamic of working in collaboration
- > Understand how to plan and manage the life of a RUP project

This course is intended for anyone expected to perform a successful role within a RUP project. This includes roles from all RUP disciplines, including project management.
